

DIY Brush Holder






We love this brush holder because it's flat, sturdy, and holds all sizes of brushes. There's plenty of space between each brush, and they stay put with a groove on each end to hold them in place.



It's easy to make out of 1/4" MDF or hardboard, and the base is 3/4" thick plywood. We used Forstner drill bits in 1/4" and 3/8" diameter to make the grooves. All you need is a little glue and some clamps to put it all together.
